PROCEDURES

1. Participants must register at the Front Office.
2. On the day of the event, participants must pre-register at the registration area, minimum one (1) hour before the competition starts and receive a cloth sticker.
3. Participants must check and confirm the competition schedule.
4. Participants are required to wait at the designated area and wait to be called by the committee.
5. Disqualification will be given to participants who are:
 - Late and are not able to present themselves after being called three (3) times
 - Not following the proper age category.
 - Inappropriate / bully behaviors: physical, emotional, taunting, calling names, talking about one another, etc. If you are a victim of this behavior, you must come to a teacher or Manager immediately so we can address this issue. Do not wait!



STUDENTS PERFORM

Baby Gymnastics participants must follow a routine of basic gymnastics movements which are carried out in class and are supplemented with certain obstacles which must be passed during the competition.



JUDGEMENT CRITERIA

Baby Gymnastics: Recording the fastest time in completing each basic gymnastics movement and the available obstacles.



UNIFORM

Comfortable clothing for moving during the competition



BABY CRAWLER

1. Babies between 6-11 months may enter the contest as long as they are not walking yet.
2. Babies below 6 months and above 12 months on the competition day will not be able to participate in the contest.
3. Registered baby and parent/legal guardian must be presented during the contest.
4. Babies will line up at the start line and at the signal, can be encouraged to crawl to the finish line.
5. Parents/legal guardians may not walk beside the child to encourage him or her and are not allowed to food to lure.
6. Only maximum of two adults will be allowed on the competition area with each baby. One adult will stay behind the baby at the start line and the other one - at the finish line.
7. Only babies are allowed to be on the competition area.
8. Babies cannot be push-started over the line.
9. Parents are NOT allowed to push, pull or touch their children while they are on competition area.
10. Participants will be disqualified if one of the parents touches the baby once the race starts.
11. Babies do not have to stay in their own lanes and rarely do.
12. Any baby standing up or begin to walk will be disqualified.
13. Any motivational strategy can be used: parents can wave toys, cell phones or keys to entice their little one to cross the finish line. No load or bad words are allowed.
14. Baby will start at the edge of the start line and first baby to crawl o the finish line wins! Baby must cross the finish line to be the winner. Each group has max of 5 min to cross the final line.
15. In case the final line was not reached by any of the participants in the group, then the whole group won't be qualified for the final.
16. Participants with the same time result will be invited for extra competition to verify winner.
17. The judges will base their decisions on what they see during each race. Videotapes are not used to determine the winner. The judges' decisions are final and unchangeable.
18. Strictly no food and drinks are allowed at the competition area!



BABY WALKER

1. Babies between 12-23 months may enter the contest as long as they have start walking.
2. Babies below 12 months and above 24 months on the competition day will not be able to participate in the contest.
3. Registered baby and parent/legal guardian must be presented during the contest.
4. Babies will line up at the start line and at the signal, will start a bean bag race.
5. Parents/legal guardians may not walk beside the child to encourage him or her and are not allowed to food to lure.
6. Only maximum of two adults will be allowed on the competition area with each baby. One adult will stay behind the baby at the start line and the other one - at the finish line.
7. Only babies are allowed to be on the competition area.
8. Babies cannot be push-started over the line.
9. Parents are NOT allowed to push, pull or touch their children while they are on competition area.
10. Participants will be disqualified if one of the parents touches the baby once the race starts.
11. Any motivational strategy can be used: parents can wave toys, cell phones or keys to entice their little one to cross the finish line. No load or bad words are allowed.

1. Babies between 24-35 months may enter the contest as long as they are participate Jumper Class.
2. Babies below 24 months and above 36 months on the competition day will not be able to participate in the contest.
3. Registered baby and parent/legal guardian must be presented during the contest.
4. Babies will line up at the start line and at the signal, will start an obstacle bean bag race.
5. Parents/legal guardians may not walk beside the child to encourage him or her and are not allowed to food to lure.
6. Only maximum of two adults will be allowed on the competition area with each baby. One adult will stay behind the baby at the start line and the other one - at the finish line.
7. Only babies are allowed to be on the competition area.
8. Babies cannot be push-started over the line.
9. Parents are NOT allowed to push, pull or touch their children while they are on competition area.
10. Participants will be disqualified if one of the parents touches the baby once the race starts.
11. Baby will start at the edge of the start line and first baby pass the finish line wins! Baby must cross the finish line to be the winner. Each group has max of 5 min to cross the final line.

2. Kids below 36 months and above 48 months on the competition day will not be able to participate in the contest.
3. Kids will line up at the start line and at the signal, will start an obstacle bean bag race.
4. Parents/legal guardians are not allowed to enter the competition area.
5. Kids will start at the edge of the start line and first child pass the finish line wins! Kids must cross the finish line to be the winner. Each group has max of 5 min to cross the final line.
6. Participants with the same time result will be invited for extra competition to verify winner.
7. The judges will base their decisions on what they see during each race. Videotapes are not used to determine the winner. The judges' decisions are final and unchangeable.
8. Strictly no food and drinks are allowed at the competition area!

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The following procedures shall be implemented whenever a student is injured in the course of activities conducted at Elite Championships.

1. The instructor shall immediately notify the health personnel present at the activity and the health personnel shall assume responsibility for the emergency treatment of the student.
2. If no health personnel are present, or if none can be immediately summoned to the student's aid, the instructor shall administer such first aid as may be necessary.
3. If the student's injury requires more than routine first aid, the instructor shall:
 - Summon an emergency personnel
 - Arrange for the student's transportation to the nearest hospital
4. The instructor or his/her designee shall promptly notify the Event Manager, the Program Coordinator, and the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the student's injury and the condition and location of the student.
5. An injured student who has been transported away from the premises must be accompanied by the instructor, a member of the Event Organizer, and the parents/guardians.

Readmission to Competition Activities

A student injured in the course of a competition activity will be permitted to participate in the competition only on the written permission of the medical inspector or designated team doctor, designated school health personnel who must first examine the student to determine his/her fitness to participate in competitions. Written notice of that determination, signed by the medical inspector or designated team doctor as appropriate, shall be given to the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s).
