Procedure

1. Students register with their teams based the age category (U5, U7, U9, U11, U13, U16).
2. Each age category will be separated by skills-based division.
3. Each Academy can send few teams per age category.
4. Each team must wear a team uniform.
5. Each team can only register min 6 & max 12 players.
6. The match system is a knockout.
7. The drawing of the match chart will be adjusted according to the registered participants.
8. Each team will play at least 2 times as the winner keep playing against the winner and the losers will be play again each other.

Registration

1. Participants must register at the Front Office (see General Procedures).
2. On the day of the event, participants must re-register at the registration room, minimum one (1) hour before the competition starts.
3. Participants must present the proof of payment/registration receipt to the committee on re-registration and receive an identity wristband.
4. Participants must check and confirm the competition schedule.
5. Participants are required to wait at the designated area and wait to be called by the committee.
6. Disqualification will be given to participants who are late and are not able to present themselves after being called three (3) times.
7. Disqualification results will be announced after the competition.

Regulation

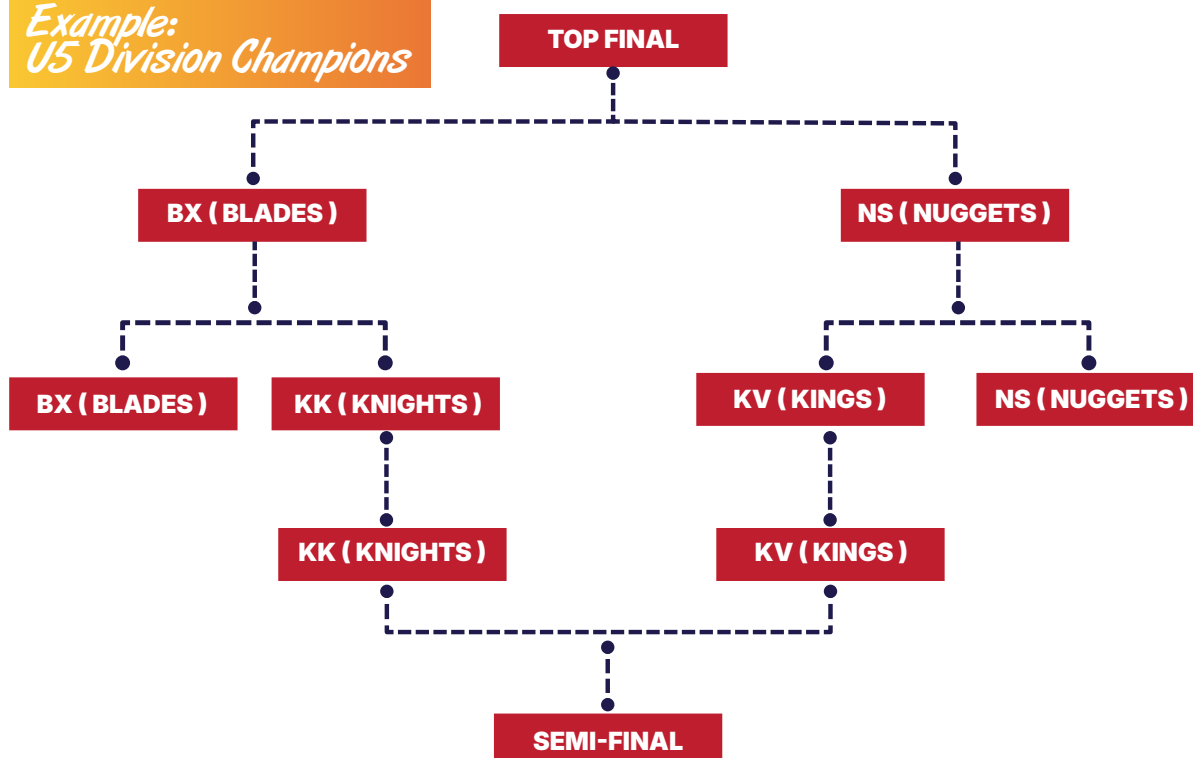
1. Game time : 2 × 10 minutes (U5).
2 X 12 minutes (U7 & U9).
2 × 15 minutes (U11, U13, & U16).
2. 2 minutes break between each quarter and 5 minutes break half time.
3. Overtime: There will be no overtime. The team will get 3 points for the winner, then get 1 point if a draw, and 0 points if they lose.
4. Students are required to use Jersey, Futsal shoes, long socks, shin guard.
5. Before game: teams will have 5-10 minutes of warming up and briefing regarding game rules with coach.
6. Rules that applied for each age category based on FIFA rules and regulation.

3. Winners will receive a Trophy per team and Certificate of Achievement (Certificates will be distributed 1 month after the event).
