Procedure

1. Players register based on their age category: 6-11 yrs & 12-18 yrs
2. Each age category will be divided by skill level (Futures, Challengers, Champions).
3. Each academy can send multiple players per age category.
4. Players must wear their academy-approved pickleball uniform.
5. Match Draws:
 - A draw will be conducted for all participants (represented by their coach) to determine matchups and brackets.
6. Bracket Format:
 - The competition format will be determined based on the total number of participants (single elimination, round-robin, or modified knockout).
7. Player Registration Limits:
 - Each academy can register a minimum of 1 player and a maximum of 5 players per category.
8. Match Participation:
 - Each player is guaranteed at least 2 matches.
 - Winners will continue to compete in the main bracket, while first-round losers will enter a consolation bracket for ranking placement.

Registration

1. Participants must register at the Front Office.
2. On the day of the event, participants must pre-register at the registration area, minimum one (1) hour before the competition starts and receive a cloth sticker.
3. Participants must check and confirm the competition schedule.
4. Participants are required to wait at the designated area and wait to be called by the committee.
5. Disqualification will be given to participants who are:
 - Late and are not able to present themselves after being called three (3) times
 - Not following the proper age category.
 - Inappropriate / bully behaviors: physical, emotional, taunting, calling names, talking about one another, etc. If you are a victim of this behavior, you must come to a teacher or Manager immediately so we can address this issue. Do not wait!

Competition Stage

1. Match Duration:

- Matches will be played in short-set format (first to 4 games, tiebreak at 3-3).
- 3 minutes will be given for warm-up.
- Changeovers will follow standard rules (90 seconds at changeovers, 2 minutes between sets).

2. Overtime & Tiebreaks:

- No extra time; if the match reaches 3-3, a 7-point tiebreak will be played.

3. Timeouts:

- Each player/team is allowed one 1-minute timeout per set.
- Medical timeouts follow ITF rules.

Equipment & Court Specifications

4. Ball Type & Court Size:

- U7 & U10 – Pickleball & 12 × 5 Meter for single Match
- U13 – Pickleball
- U16 & U18 – Pickleball

5. Grace Period:

- A 5-minute grace period will be given for late players. After this, the match clock will start.
- If a player is not present within 10 minutes, the match will be forfeited.

Scoring & Rules

6. Faults & Penalties:

- Players are allowed one faults per serve.
- Code violations will result in warnings, point penalties, or disqualification based on ITF standards.

7. Coaching & On-Court Behavior:

- Coaching is not allowed during points but may be permitted during changeovers in team events.
- Players must follow proper sportsmanship; misconduct may lead to penalties.

8. Match Progression:

- Knockout Stage: Top players from each group advance to semifinals & finals.

Dress Code & Player Requirements

9. Uniform & Attire:

- All players must wear tennis jerseys.
- Pickleball shoes must be worn (no running shoes allowed).

10. Jewelry & Accessories:

- No jewelry allowed (necklaces, earrings, and watches must be removed).

Official Regulations

11. Rules & Officiating:

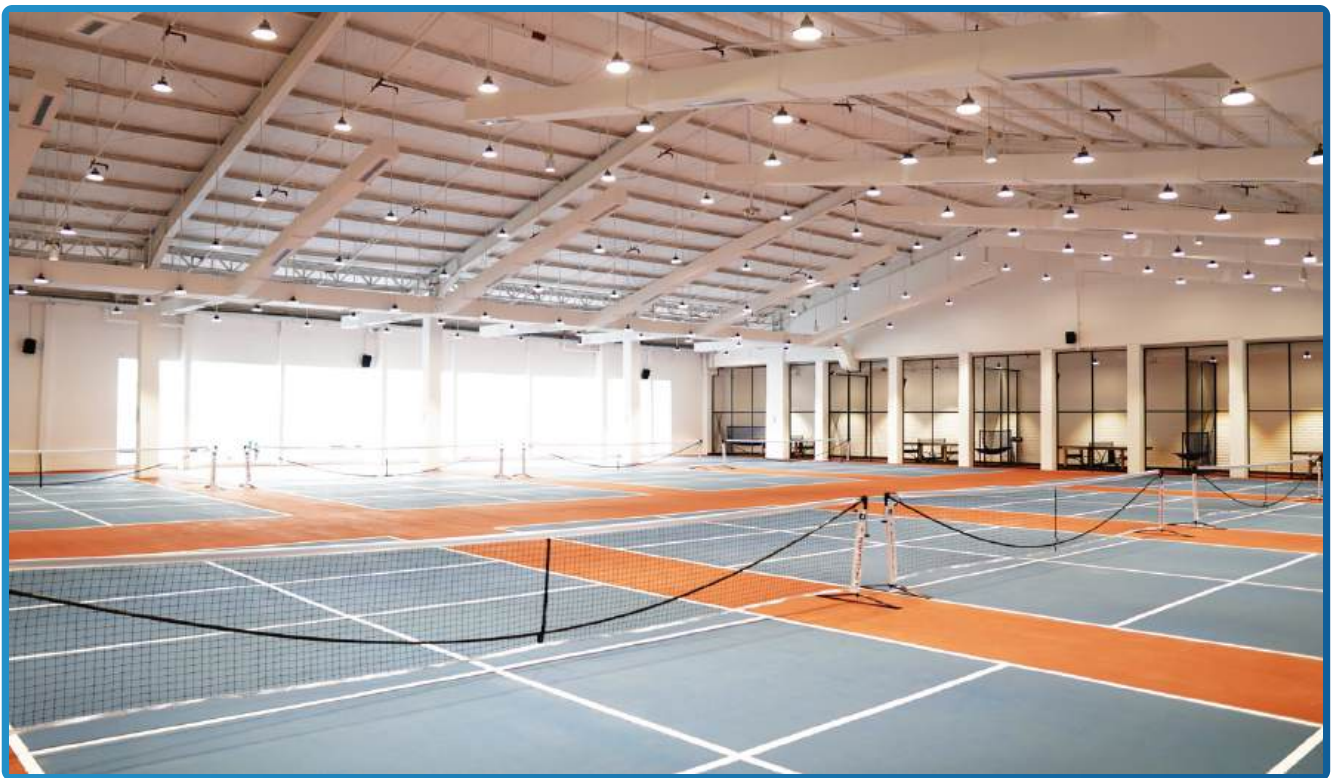
- ITF rules will apply, with modifications for junior categories (e.g., no let rule for U10).
- Umpires/referees will oversee matches to ensure fair play.

Awarding Ceremony

1. Awarding Ceremony will be done after each age category match.
2. Winners for each category: 1st Position (Gold), 2nd Position (Silver), 3rd Positions (Bronze).
3. Winners will receive a Medal and Certificate of Achievement (Certificates will be distributed 1 month after the event).
