## Procedure

1. Players register based on their age category: 6-11 yrs, 12-18 yrs.
2. Each age category will be divided by skill level (Futures, Challengers, Champions).
3. Each academy can send multiple players per age category.
4. Players must wear their academy-approved table tennis uniform.
5. Match Draws: A draw will be conducted for all participants (represented by their coach) to determine matchups and brackets.
6. Bracket Format: The competition format will be determined based on the total number of participants (single elimination, round-robin, or modified knockout).
7. Player Registration Limits: Each academy can register a minimum of 1 player and a maximum of 5 players per category.
8. Match Participation:
  - Each player is guaranteed at least 2 matches.
  - Winners will continue to compete in the main bracket, while first-round losers will enter a consolation bracket for ranking placement.

## Registration

1. Participants must register at the Front Office.
2. On the day of the event, participants must pre-register at the registration area, minimum one (1) hour before the competition starts and receive a cloth sticker.
3. Participants must check and confirm the competition schedule.
4. Participants are required to wait at the designated area and wait to be called by the committee.
5. Disqualification will be given to participants who are:
  - Late and are not able to present themselves after being called three (3) times
  - Not following the proper age category.
  - Inappropriate / bully behaviors: physical, emotional, taunting, calling names, talking about one another, etc. If you are a victim of this behavior, you must come to a teacher or Manager immediately so we can address this issue. Do not wait!

# Competition Stage

## Match Format

### 1. Match Duration:

- Matches will be played in a best-of-3 games format for preliminary rounds.
- Finals will be best-of-5 games.
- Each game is played to 11 points, with a 2-point margin required to win.

### 2. Overtime & Tiebreaks:

- If both players reach 10-10, the game continues until one player leads by 2 points.

### 3. Timeouts:

- Each player is allowed one 1-minute timeout per match.
- Medical timeouts follow ITTF rules.

## Equipment & Court Specifications

### 4. Ball & Table Size:

- Standard 40+mm plastic balls will be used.
- Matches will be played on standard-size tables (9ft x 5ft, 30 inches high).

### 5. Grace Period:

- A 5-minute grace period will be given for late players.
- If a player is not present within 10 minutes, the match will be forfeited.

## Scoring & Rules

### 6. Faults & Penalties:

- Players must serve two consecutive times before switching.
- Illegal serves or ball contact violations will result in a point awarded to the opponent.
- Any misconduct (unsportsmanlike behavior, delaying the game, etc.) will lead to warnings, point penalties, or disqualification.

### 7. Coaching & On-Court Behavior:

- Coaching is only allowed during set breaks.
- Players must follow proper sportsmanship; repeated violations may lead to disqualification.

### 8. Match Progression:

- Group Stage: Round-robin format.
- Knockout Stage: Top players from each group advance to elimination rounds.

## Dress Code & Player Requirements

### 9. Uniform & Attire:

- All players must wear Rockstar Academy table tennis jerseys.
- Non-marking sports shoes must be worn.

### 10. Jewelry & Accessories:

- No jewelry allowed (necklaces, earrings, and watches must be removed).

## Official Regulations

### 11. Rules & Officiating:

- ITTF (International Table Tennis Federation) rules will apply.
- Umpires/referees will ensure fair play.

## Awarding Ceremony

1. Awarding Ceremony will be done after each age category match.
2. Winners for each category: 1<sup>st</sup> Position (Gold), 2<sup>nd</sup> Position (Silver), 3<sup>rd</sup> Positions (Bronze).
3. Winners will receive a Medal and Certificate of Achievement (Certificates will be distributed 1 month after the event).
