Procedure

1. Students register with their teams based the age category (U7, U9 Mix, U9 Girls, U11 Mix, U11 Girls, U13, U13 Girls, 14+ Mix, 14+ Girls)
2. Each age category will be separated by skills-based division.
3. Each Academy can send few teams per age category.
4. Each team must wear a team uniform.
5. There will be drawing for all teams (represented by Head coach) on each category to determine their match up and bracket.
6. Bracket will be made based on total team participated.
7. Each team can only register min 5 & max 15 players.
8. Each team will play at least 2 times as the winner keep playing against the winner and the losers will be play again each other.

Registration

1. Participants must register at the Front Office.
2. On the day of the event, participants must pre-register at the registration area, minimum one (1) hour before the competition starts and receive a cloth sticker.
3. Participants must check and confirm the competition schedule.
4. Participants are required to wait at the designated area and wait to be called by the committee.
5. Disqualification will be given to participants who are:
Late and are not able to present themselves after being called three (3) times
Not following the proper age category.
Inappropriate / bully behaviors: physical, emotional, taunting, calling names, talking about one another, etc. If you are a victim of this behavior, you must come to a teacher or Manager immediately so we can address this issue. Do not wait!

Competition Stage

1. **Game Clock:** Games will consist of Four 10 minutes. 3 minutes will be given to warm up. Games will be played with 1-minute half times. Time will keep running (in bound, free throw, time out, etc.).
2. **Overtime:** There will be no overtime. If the scores are tied, decision will be made by free throw.
3. **Time Outs:** Each team will be given 1 time out (1 minute) per quarter, and cannot be accumulated
4. **Ball Size :**
 - U7 Mix and U10 Mix will use ball size 5.
 - U13 Mix and U16-18 Girls will use ball size 6.
 - U16-18 Boys will use ball size 7.
5. **Grace Period:** A two minutes grace period will be allowed for tardiness and then if a team does not have four players to start the game, the game clock will start. Eight minutes will be allowed for a team to present four players to start. The team ready and waiting will begin amassing two points per minute up to eight minutes. If at this point a team does not have four players to start, a forfeit will be declared.
6. **Team Fouls:** Players will be given 5 fouls per game. Bonus shots will be given after the 6th team foul, and the team will be in double bonus after the 10th team foul, per half.
7. **Technical Fouls:** All technical fouls will count as a personal foul. A player who receives a technical foul must sit out of the game for three minutes before he/she will be allowed back into the game. If a player receives a second technical foul during the same game, the player will be ejected from the competition.
8. **3-Pointers:** High School 3-point line will be utilized in all games. (19' line).
9. **Pressing:** Full court pressing is allowed, however, there will be no pressing if a team is 20 points ahead.
10. **In Final,** Winner Group A will play against Winner Group B for the 1st and 2nd place. Runner Up Group A will play against Runner Up Group B for 3rd place.
11. **Rules applied for each age category** are based on FIBA rules and regulations (except there will be no 24 seconds).

Uniform

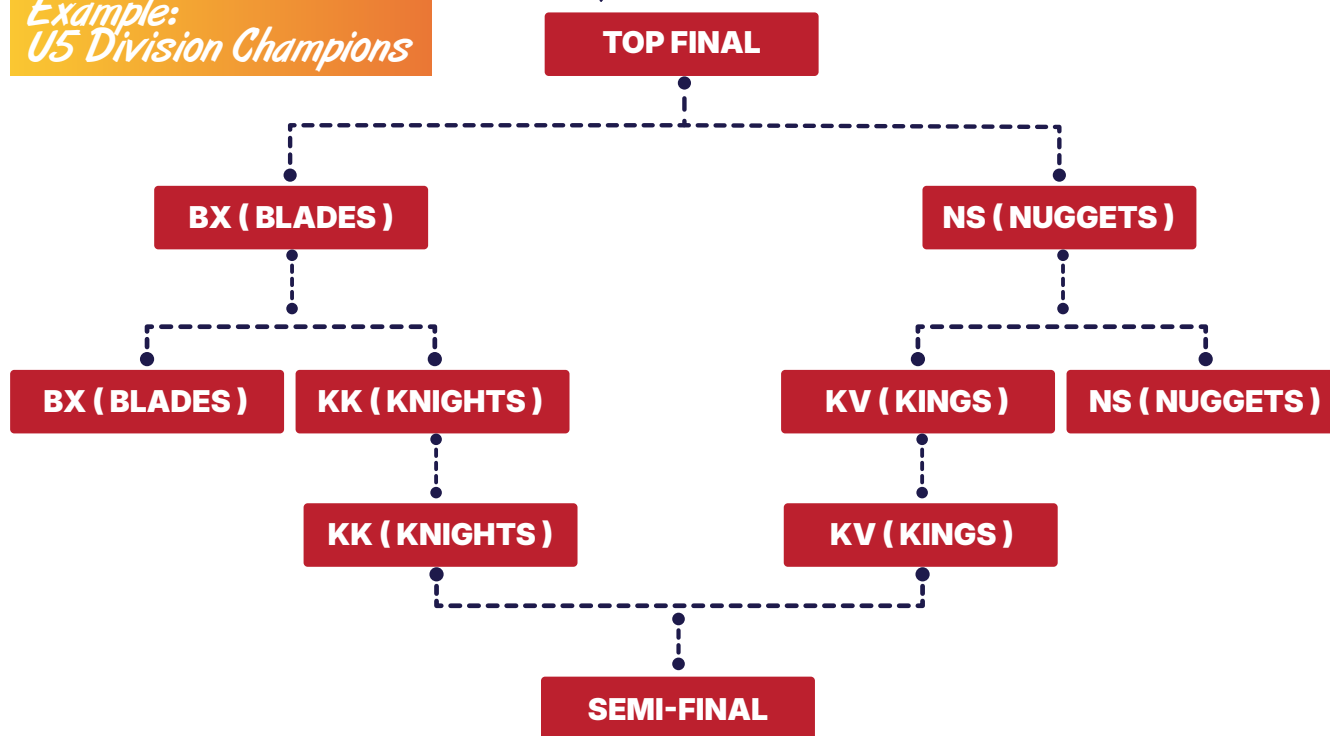
1. All team players must wear Rockstar Academy basketball jerseys.
2. Each jersey must have the same color and they must have numbers.
3. Basketball shoes must be worn.
4. All jewelry must be removed. Necklaces, earrings and watches cannot be worn during the game.
