PRE-REGISTRATION

1. Students must pre-register at the registration desk, minimum one (1) hour before the testing starts.
2. Registration Desk is in front of the sports court.
3. Students will be provide with a Chest Number.
4. Students must be ready in their uniforms (Dobok with current Belt).

PROCEDURES

1. Testers will be divided based on their current Belt level/color.
2. Testers will be called to the arena for skills mastery.
3. Instructors will explain testing material.
4. Judges:
 - a. White Belt: Danu Permadiaji.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Students must register according to their current belt level.
2. Students will be tested on the following skills:
 - Kicking (Chagi).
 - Form (Taegeuk).
 - Block (Makki).
 - Punching (Jiurugi).
3. Procedure for testing:
 - Recap points of the Taekwondo Testing will be submitted to PBTI one week after the test. All scores are final.
 - Certificates and belts will be presented to students 3 months after the testing by Taekwondo Instructors during Taekwondo Classes.
 - In case where students do not attend the class of Certificate & Belt presentation, their Certificates & Belts will be available at the Front Desk and can be obtained from the Academy Manager of respective academy.
4. By completing the event payment, parents acknowledge and agree to the event Term & Conditions.
5. All registration fees are non-refundable.
6. Parents are permitted to watch the competition from outside the competition room.
7. All judgment results are final and are not open for discussion.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The following procedures shall be implemented whenever a student is injured in the course of testing conducted.

1. The instructor shall immediately notify the health personnel present at the activity and the health personnel shall assume responsibility for the emergency treatment of the student.
2. If no health personnel are present, or if none can be immediately summoned to the student's aid, the instructor shall administer such first aid as may be necessary.
3. If the student's injury requires more than routine first aid, the instructor shall:
 - a. Summon an emergency personnel.
 - b. Arrange for the student's transportation to the nearest hospital.
4. The instructor or his/her designee shall promptly notify the Event Manager, the Program Coordinator, and the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the student's injury and the condition and location of the student.
5. An injured student who has been transported away from the premises must be accompanied by the instructor, a member of the Event Organizer, and the parents/guardians.

READMISSION TO COMPETITION ACTIVITIES

A student injured in the course of a testing activity will be permitted to participate in the testing only on the written permission of the medical inspecctor or designated team doctor, designated health personnel who must first examine the student to determine his/her fitness to participate in competitions. Written notice of that determination, signed by the medical inspector or designated team doctor as appropriate, shall be given to the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s).
